Established in 1992, Limelight Theatre is the only year-round community theatre located in St. Augustine, Florida. In addition to presenting eight mainstage productions each season, Limelight offers year-round theatre education for ages 4 to adult and special events produced by the St. Augustine Film Festival and The Amp.

Co-founded by Anne Kraft and Jean Rahner, the Limelight Theatre staged its first production on August 28, 1992, in the Monson Bayfront Inn. It provided entertainment at this location for almost two years. In 1994, Limelight achieved non-profit status as a 501(c)3 organization, and continued to offer productions for a number of years at a wide variety of local venues, including a small rented building on U.S. 1.

In 2001, through a generous grant from the Joukowsky Family Foundation, the Limelight purchased a 10,000 square foot building at 11 Old Mission Avenue in uptown St. Augustine, and converted it to a theatre, thus moving into its first permanent home.

Beth Lambert led the organization as Executive Director for many seasons and was a talented actress and director. She was beloved in St. Augustine and helped shape Limelight into a pillar of the community.

Sherrie Provence took over as Executive Director in 2022 and led the organization through renovations and new leadership, bringing Limelight into a new chapter of professional theatre.







Director's Note



This story begins in the aftermath of a loss of the mom and wife of the century, Cecily Smith. But *FLY BY NIGHT* is truly the exploration of every character's navigation of loss in their personal lives. It looks deeply into the human condition and the need in every heart to be seen and find authentic connection. There are themes of love and romance, but it is a much deeper than that.

The intersection of lives in this story reveals how we look desperately to the other people in our circles to validate us, value us, give us worth, and make us significant. But when they fail, we often just look to someone else until we find that person who really sees us. Very possibly, however, the issue lies inside of us and the need to find our own self love and acceptance, following our own path with independence and confidence.

Our paths may at times be solitary, but we are all actually connected in ways that we cannot see that affect us in ways we may never understand. As the energy shifts with each person that we meet and every action that is made, it is like the butterfly effect. For those who have never heard this term, it is the concept that small changes (the mere flapping of a butterflies wings) can lead to largely altered outcomes (like a change in the weather,) making the future completely unpredictable by a practically invisible and unmeasurable action. And if you believe that this can happen, every choice you make and action you take may be made with greater intent and caution.

This is what you will see tonight...an invisible ripple that changes the world in its own way. And nothing can stop this ripple...not even total darkness.




