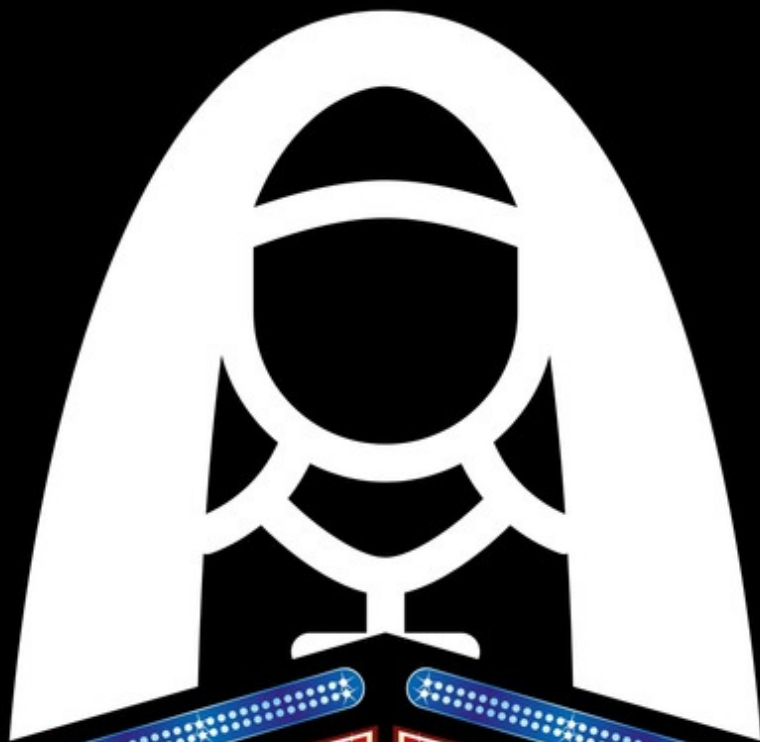

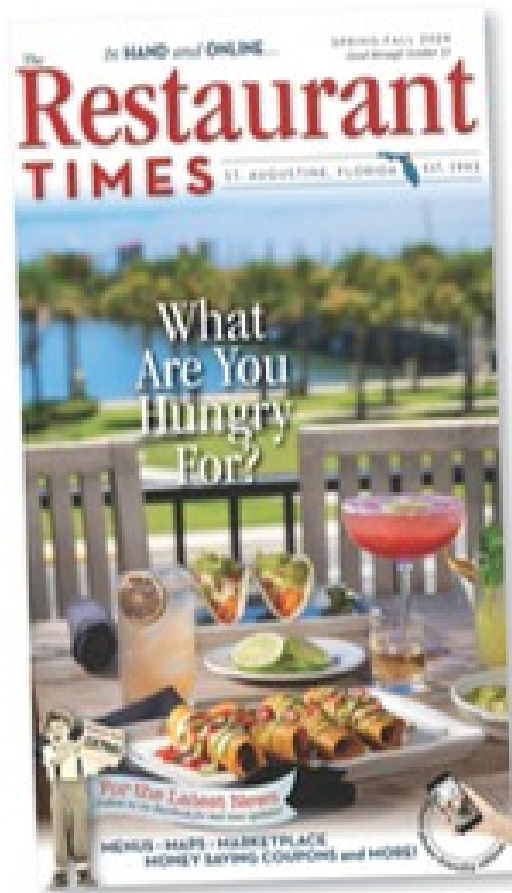

Established in 1992, Limelight Theatre is the only year-round community theatre located in St. Augustine, FL. In addition to presenting eight mainstage productions each season, Limelight offers year-round theatre education for ages 4 to adult and special events produced by the St. Augustine Film Festival and The Amp.

Co-founded by Anne Kraft and Jean Rahner, the Limelight Theatre staged its first production on August 28, 1992, in the Monson Bayfront Inn. It provided entertainment at this location for almost two years. In 1994, Limelight achieved non-profit status as a 501(c)3 organization, and continued to offer productions for a number of years at a wide variety of local venues, including a small rented building on U.S. 1.

In 2001, through a generous grant from the Joukowsky Family Foundation, the Limelight purchased a 10,000 square foot building at 11 Old Mission Avenue in uptown St. Augustine, and converted it to a theatre, thus moving into its first permanent home.

Beth Lambert led the organization as Executive Director for many seasons and was a talented actress and director. She was beloved in St. Augustine and helped shape Limelight into a pillar of the community.

Sherrie Provence took over as Executive Director in 2022 and led the organization through renovations and new leadership, bringing Limelight into a new chapter of professional theatre.

Welcome to the Season of Faith!



When I put together a season at Limelight, I start with a long list of plays that capture my imagination — stories I believe would resonate with our community. Over weeks of reflection, I try to find just the right formula: a season that excites, challenges, and uplifts our audiences. This year, I found myself asking: *What does the world need more of right now?* The answer that kept rising to the surface was faith.

As a storyteller, I believe every story must carry elements of hope. They should challenge or affirm our deepest values and leave us with something to hold onto. But when I explored the idea of “faith,” I realized that while faith and hope are closely connected, they live in different spaces of belief and expectation.

- Hope is the anticipation of what lies ahead — the desire for something good to come.
 - Faith is rooted in the present — the conviction that something is true and reliable now.
- Faith is what makes hope possible.

Faith can be placed in humanity, in love, in God, or simply in the greater good. It gives us assurance, conviction, and the courage to wrestle with challenging moral questions. Hope says, *“I look forward to it happening,”* faith says, *“I believe it is true now.”* And don’t we need something now? We need faith.

In theatre, it takes faith in trusting the script before the curtain ever rises — believing the story will unfold, even when the ending is unseen. Hope is the anticipation in the wings, imagining the applause and the shared moment with the audience when the final scene lands. Faith keeps us rehearsing. Hope keeps us dreaming of opening night. And here we are...manifesting through “faith” what was unseen in the beginning. Thank you for sharing in this season of “faith” at the Limelight — and thank you for having faith in the arts.

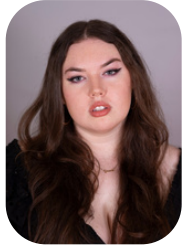
Cast

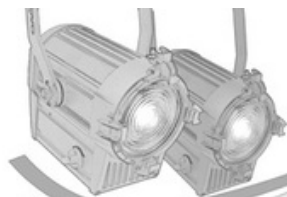
