

#### Stephen Billy, Director

Stephen Billy is the visionary force behind River City Theatre (RCT), a lifelong dream that has blossomed into a vibrant reality. His journey into the world of theatre began at the age of nine when he first stepped onto the stage in a production of *The Secret Garden*. That spark ignited a passion that has only grown richer over the years, cultivating a deep sense of belonging and connection to the arts. In the years since, Stephen has established a robust background in arts administration, theatre education, and directing. He has

dedicated his life to creating spaces where creativity flourishes, friendships blossom, and the magic of theatre can foster the imaginations of future generations.

Stephen graduated from the University of Montevallo in 2013 before earning a master's degree in arts administration and cultural policy from Goldsmiths, University of London. His professional journey includes impactful roles such as Company Manager for Ogunquit Playhouse in 2015 and Executive Artistic Director for Brewton Town and Gown Players from 2016 to 2020. During this time, he also directed the annual production of *To Kill a Mockingbird* in Monroeville, Alabama, drawing hundreds of visitors to the birthplace of Nelle Harper Lee.



From 2020 to 2024, Stephen served as the Theatre Instructor and Program Manager at Bartram Trail High School, where he directed beloved productions including Roald Dahl's Matilda, Noises Off, Murder on the Orient Express, Chicago, Beauty and the Beast, Clue, Junie B. Jones, and You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown. His directing repertoire also features classics such as Oklahoma, Roald Dahl's Willy Wonka, A Christmas Carol, Chitty Chitty Bang Bang, The Wizard of Oz, The Best Christmas Pageant Ever, To Kill a Mockingbird, Annie, and Steel Magnolias, showcasing his commitment to nurturing young talent and inspiring creativity in his students.

As the Executive Artistic Director of RCT, Stephen fosters a collaborative environment where imagination

thrives, and every participant feels at home. His unwavering dedication to the arts has created a sanctuary for artists and audiences alike, ensuring that the spark he felt as a boy continues to ignite the dreams of others. Under his leadership, River City Theatre stands as a beacon of creativity and community, inviting everyone to experience the transformative power of the stage.

#### Katie Raulerson Padilla, Choreographer

Katie is a NYC-based actress originally from St.
Augustine. She graduated from the University of Montevallo with her BFA in Musical Theatre. Select choreography credits include *Big River* and *The Rocky Horror Show* (University of Montevallo); *Massterpiece Donut Shop* (EWTN Catholic broadcast network); *Chicago, Matilda,* and *Beauty and the Beast* (Bartram Trail High School); *Celebration* (ABET); and *Oklahoma* (Limelight Theatre). #### Dr. Clinton M. H. Weinberg, Music Director

Dr. Clinton M. H. Weinberg, baritone, is an accomplished performer and educator based in Northeast Florida. He began his musical journey as an instrumentalist before earning a B.M. in Classical Voice from the University of North Florida. He pursued graduate studies in Voice Performance and Music Education at Valdosta State University and the University of Florida, holds an M.A.Ed. from Bethel University, and completed both an Ed.S. and Ed.D. in Curriculum and Instruction from the University of West Florida. Additionally, he is a

licensed massage therapist specializing in treatment for performing artists.

Dr. Weinberg has taught since 1999, serving institutions including
Duval County Public Schools, Theatre Jacksonville, Amelia Arts Academy,
J.U. School of Music, the Cathedral Arts Project, and Wehner's SOTA. At the
collegiate level, he has held positions as Graduate Teaching Assistant at
Valdosta State, Adjunct of Applied Voice at Jacksonville University, and
Instructor of Clinical Massage Therapy at Southeastern College. He currently
serves as Resident Artist and Coordinator of Applied Instrument at Flagler
College, where he teaches voice and directs the College Chorale and the Pep
Band & Drumline.

As a recitalist, Dr. Weinberg has performed widely along the East Coast. Notable solo appearances include Handel's Messiah, Dubois' Seven Last Words of Christ, Schubert's Mass in G, Fauré's Requiem, and Beethoven's Mass in C. Favorite operatic roles include the Father (Hansel and Gretel), Don Giovanni, and Count Almaviva (The Marriage of Figaro). As an instrumentalist, he has performed with the U.S. Army Field Band and in numerous pit orchestras for regional and touring productions. He is a past President and current Vice President of the North Florida Chapter of NATS.
