Established in 1992, Limelight Theatre is the only year-round community theatre located in St. Augustine, Florida. In addition to presenting eight mainstage productions each season, Limelight offers year-round theatre education for ages 4 to adult and special events produced by the St. Augustine Film Festival and The Amp.

Co-founded by Anne Kraft and Jean Rahner, the Limelight Theatre staged its first production on August 28, 1992, in the Monson Bayfront Inn. It provided entertainment at this location for almost two years. In 1994, Limelight achieved non-profit status as a 501(c)3 organization, and continued to offer productions for a number of years at a wide variety of local venues, including a small rented building on U.S. 1.

In 2001, through a generous grant from the Joukowsky Family Foundation, the Limelight purchased a 10,000 square foot building at 11 Old Mission Avenue in uptown St. Augustine, and converted it to a theatre, thus moving into its first permanent home.

Beth Lambert led the organization as Executive Director for many seasons and was a talented actress and director. She was beloved in St. Augustine and helped shape Limelight into a pillar of the community.

Sherrie Provence took over as Executive Director in 2022 and led the organization through renovations and new leadership, bringing Limelight into a new chapter of professional theatre.

It is no small endeavor to stage a period Jane Austen play. I am afraid we have far outlived the delicacies and genteelness of the gallantry and refinement of this historic era. The language is dense and objectives are subtly nuanced with just the right looks and gestures to accompany the beautifully crafted words. But we had more people come audition for this play than we have had come out for a play in the last three years.

In the British Regency period, we get to see romance and manipulation with an 18th century flair, adorned with beautiful costumes and elegant style. Jane Austen's novel, and Kate Hamill's delightfully humorous adaptation, explores the innocence and longing of unrequited love and the proper ways to catch and keep a man of means. She begs the question of whether it should be with sense or sensibility, approaching this dilemma with rationale and practicality or in the embrace of romance and idealism. Which one will win in the end? It is easy to see ourselves in these characters, although the story takes place centuries ago, the hope for love, connection, and true happiness exists in us all. 



Director's Note



Sense and Sensibility was the first novel published by Jane Austen, in 1811. It was published anonymously, with "By A Lady" on the original title page. In 2014, Kate Hamill adapted the novel for the stage, and received an Alliance Award and several nominations. The playwright's desire to share these wonderful female-driven narratives from Jane Austen's world was something that I was excited to present on stage, and I did so with the utmost respect for both of these incredible writers.

Kate Hamill describes the depth of how Jane Austen reveals to us "the silent desperation that women in patriarchal structures face, of the struggle to regulate your own behavior based on outside norms that have nothing to do with who you really are." As we at the Limelight Theatre celebrate Jane Austen's 250th birthday, (as only true "Janeites" can) I'm reminded of how challenging it must have been to depict this depth of the human experience at a time when a woman's voice was rarely heard. As I dove into the world of Kate Hamill's version of this story, I was fascinated by the liberty she gives the director to "play and have fun" with all of the different moving scenes, and the intricate details of the characters.

The fabulous collaboration that I have experienced with every single person who had anything to do with this production is something that I feel Jane Austen is smiling down on as we present it to you. I hope you allow yourselves to open up this story, escape from life for a couple of hours, and walk out knowing that you, and everything you stand for, is of the utmost significance.


