DIRECTOR'S NOTES

When I learned Theatre Jacksonville was producing a show centered around the lives of those with intellectual disabilities, I knew I wanted to be a part of it. When Sarah Boone gave me the opportunity to direct it, I thought I might collapse under the sheer magnitude of presenting this story in a way that would celebrate a wonderful yet under-represented community.

Over the past year, I had to do what directors often have to do: find the similarities in characters and stories and make them relatable to an audience. Have you ever had a crush on someone? Have you ever been burnt out from a job? Do you have a favorite food that often you overindulge? Maybe you've had big feelings you weren't quite sure how to express. Or perhaps someone saw you as slower than the rest of the group. These are experiences we've all had. These are ways we connect with not only our personal communities but all communities.

I want to thank you for buying a ticket to a show you've probably not seen or heard of. Maybe you've seen the 1995 movie adaptation with Nathan Lane. Maybe you thought this was a stage version of the 1985 thriller under the same title starring Charlie Sheen. No matter how you ended up here, thank you. Your support of the theater community as well as the community represented in tonight's show will bring a sometimes-divided world a little closer.

COMPANY BIOS




